

BILLY JOE "B.J" HALL

He also assisted Don Holland and Jerry Sneary in constructing Horseshoe Pitching Courts at LSU-Shreveport and parks here in the Shreveport area.

He has been a member of the Shreveport Double-Ringer Horseshoe Pitching League since he became sanctioned, never missing a league season since he joined.

As indicated above, he has pitched in just about every tournament sponsored by the Shreveport Horseshoe Pitchers Association and the Moose Lodge #2239 Horseshoe Pitching Club since he joined the NHPA, maintaining a Ringer Percentage of approximately 33.0%.
