Dudley Michel was born and raised in Morgan City, La., and began playing horseshoes in that area of the State in the early 1990's, playing in local festival and Church Tournaments.

In 1992-1993, Dudley, together with Bob Scully, Rodney Fromenthal, and Jimmy Percle, met with Jack Atchley and Bob Hogan, and the formation of the first sanctioned Club in his area, "The LA 70 Ringers" resulted.

Dudley was the first President of the LA 70 Ringers, who were responsible for the construction of the first courts at Kemper Williams Park in Patterson in 1994, and began hosting sanctioned events in 1995.

He donated his time and expertise in the construction of the facilities at Kemper Williams in Patterson, supplying the material and labor for the courts. He still provides his time and know-how to the upgrade and maintenance of the facilities.
