In the early 1980's, Jerry met Don Holland at work at General Motors and was introduced to horseshoes. He quickly became an avid enthusiast of the game and assisted Don Holland and Ken Stewart in organizing the Shreveport Horseshoe Pitchers Association (SHPA) and constructing the local horseshoe courts on which the SHPA sponsors numerous Tournaments and the Double-Ringer Horseshoe Pitching Leagues each year.

Jerry has pitched a 70% ringer game on three different occasions, in 1990, 1994, and 1999.
