

JIMMY PERCLE

Jimmy Percle was born and raised in Morgan City, La., and began playing horseshoes in that area of the State in the early 1990's, playing in local festival and Church Tournaments.

He was introduced to organized horseshoes in 1993 by other local enthusiasts Rodney Fromenthal and Bob Scully. He was an original member of the first sanctioned club in his area, the "LA 70 Ringers".

Jimmy instantly became a very involved member of the LA 70 Ringers, as that 12 man group began construction of the first ten courts at Kemper Williams Park in Patterson, which became a regular venue for sanction Tournaments, and hosted their first State Tournament in 1995. Jimmy was President of that Club when it disbanded to form the Bayou Horseshoe Pitchers Association in 1998.

He has consistently donated his time and expertise in the construction of the facilities at Kemper Williams in Patterson, supplying the material and construction for the score table and concession buildings, the sponsor board and the BHPA logo. He continually provides materials and his know-how to the upgrade and maintenance of the facilities.

Jimmy is currently the Fourth Vice President of the BHPA, serving as Chairmen of all Banquet and Concession activities.
