Lester Waguespack, better known as "Wag", was born in Vacherie, La. and moved to Morgan City in 1965, where he and his wife, Alice, raised their four children. He is now retired, having worked with auto dealerships throughout his career.

Wag started playing horseshoes in 1972 when he participated in his first Knights of Columbus Tournament. Wag won his first State K.C. Tournament in 1981, finishing second and third numerous times. He claimed that same State title in the Elders division in 2004, 2005, 2006, and 2010. Wag was a member and served as Treasurer of the Atchafalaya Horseshoe Club, a predecessor to the Bayou Horseshoe Pitchers Association. He served as the first Treasurer of the Bayou Horseshoe Pitchers Association for the first ten years of their existence.
