

O. S. (SID) PLOTT

Born in Kansas City, Missouri in 1906, Otis Sidney Plott moved to Shreveport as a high school junior.

He pitched his first World Tournament in 1927 at the age of 21 and shot a very respectable 40 percent in Duluth, Minn. and was recognized as the Louisiana State Champion.

In 1929, a State Tournament was held staged by the *Shreveport Times*, and again Sid was the Champion.

Sid won the Class "B" World Tournament Title in 1959, shooting an impressive 64 percent.

In 1985, he won the World Class "C" Championship in the 70 years and over division.

Also in 1985, he presented his son-in-law and granddaughter their State Championship trophies, bringing the state title back into the family.

In 1987, *The Horseshoe Pitcher's News Digest* recognized Sid Plott as the charter member of the Louisiana State Association's Hall of Fame.

Mr. Plott passed way in March of 1992, but his legacy as a pioneer in Horseshoes in the State of Louisiana will live forever in these archives.

The annual Sid Plott Memorial Tournament is held in Welsh, Louisiana, each year in his memory.
